Your letter postmarked April 4, 1961, has been received, and I am pleased to learn of your interest in the FBI. I am enclosing some material about our organization which you may wish to have.

With regard to your question, Elliot Ness was employed as a Prohibition Agent in the Internal Revenue Service and later was transferred to the Bureau of Prohibition in the Department of Justice. He was never a Special Agent of the FBI.

The FBI has had no part in the production of "The Untouchables" and does not endorse it in any manner. The programs have often involved fictitious accounts of actual cases handled by the FBI. Beyond this, I am not in a position to comment on the accuracy of these programs.

SA [redacted]
50 TV shows on How To Play Baseball. These shows will run five to seven minutes and will be hosted by Los Angeles Dodgers' pitcher DON DRYSDALE. If this series receives the desired response from the public, similar programs on football and basketball may be syndicated for TV programming.

While the program is a commercial venture, it is designed to encourage physical fitness and discourage juvenile delinquency among youth by stimulating participation in a well supervised sport.

[redacted] letter pointed out that the producers of the show are trying to get as much intelligent cooperation on the project as possible, and believe that one of the best things that could happen would be to receive a letter of commendation from Director HOOVER. If possible, the producers would like to send a camera crew to make a 10 or 15 second film with Mr. HOOVER telling the public that this is the type of thing that will keep youngsters off the streets and make better American citizens out of them.

A brochure on the program as received with [redacted] letter is forwarded herewith for the Bureau's information.

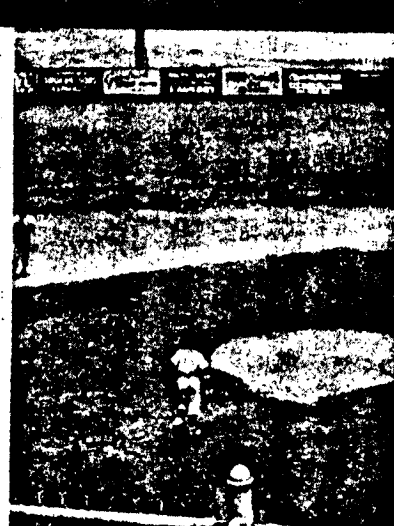

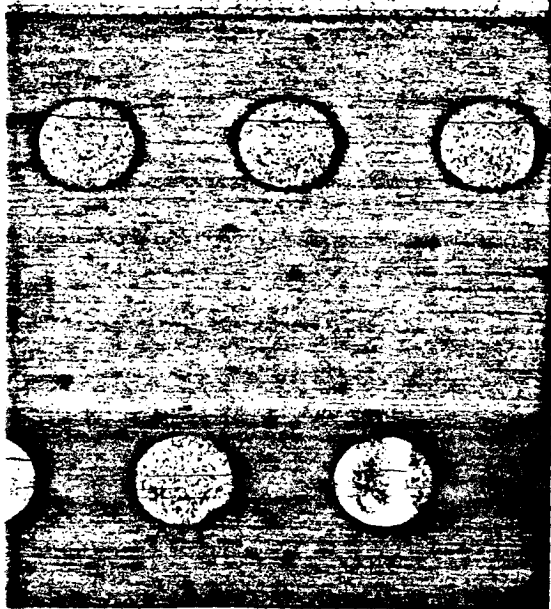
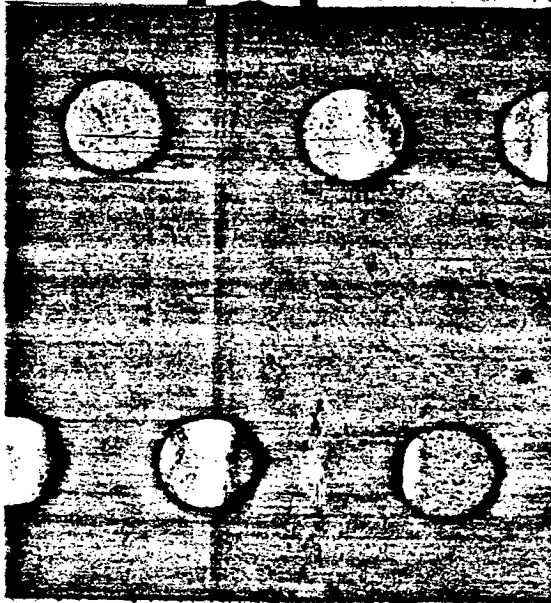

Subject matter is baseball instruction and the host is the Los Angeles Dodgers' pitcher, Don Drysdale. SAC, Los Angeles further advised [redacted] had pointed out that the program, while commercial in nature, is designed to encourage physical fitness and to discourage juvenile delinquency. [redacted] therefore requested a letter of commendation from the Director and stated that he would like to send a camera crew to Washington to make a 10 or 15 second film of the Director telling the public that this program is the type of thing that will keep youngsters off the streets and make better American citizens out of them. A brochure concerning the program is attached. [redacted] letter has been acknowledged by SAC, Los Angeles, and he was advised that his request was being forwarded to Washington for the Director's reaction. No encouragement concerning this matter was given to [redacted]. No derogatory information identifiable with [redacted] in the files of the Los Angeles Office.

By letter dated July 14th to the Director, a representative of the firm of Desi Arnaz Productions, Inc., submitted a resume of captioned individual in which [REDACTED] had listed as one of his references, "J. Edgar Hoover, Semi Retired Policeman." The representative of Desi Arnaz Productions, Inc., requested to be informed if [REDACTED] was known to the Director.

By telegram dated 7-19-66 that representative was advised that [REDACTED] was not known to the Director and by airtel of the same date SAC Miami was instructed to contact [REDACTED] and to admonish him to desist from using the Director's name as a reference. By airtel dated 7-22-66, SAC Miami advised that that office had contacted [REDACTED] and admonished him to refrain from future use of the Director's name. [REDACTED] was very apologetic and explained that he knew that Desi Arnaz was an associate of the Director and that in a conversation with Arnaz he had mentioned in a humorous vein that he is acquainted with the Director. He stated that Arnaz had accepted the remark as a jest and that in subsequently preparing a resume for submission to Arnaz he had used the Director's name in continuation of what he regarded as a jest.

Captioned individual has written to the Director under date of July 22nd and stated he has been contacted by an Agent of this Bureau. He is very apologetic for using the Director's name in such a manner and expresses the esteem in which he holds the Director and the FBI. He states that he feels the Director will realize that what was

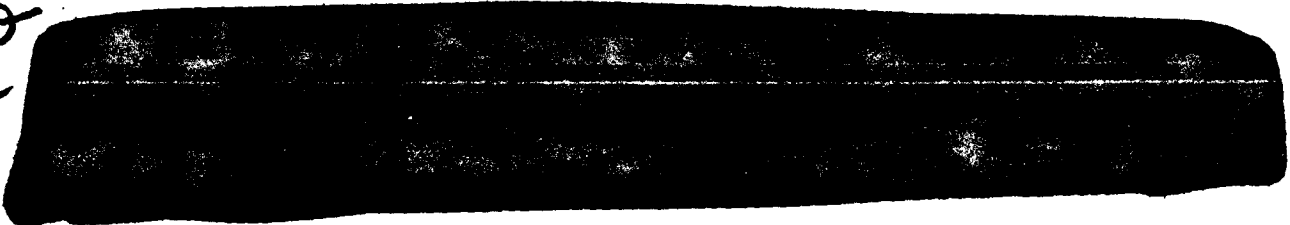
